

The Undergraduate Architecture Program at UGM began in 1962 and is part of the Faculty of Engineering. The program holds an “Excellent” accreditation from BAN-PT DIKTI and is internationally accredited by the Korea Architectural Accrediting Board (KAAB). Since 2018, its graduates have earned the degree of Bachelor of Architecture (S.Ars.).

The program focuses on producing graduates with the following core competencies:

1. Formulating Design Concept
2. Develop a Viable and Functional Form
3. Determine the Use of Relevant
4. Presenting the Idea and the Design
5. Behave Professionally

As well as additional competencies:

1. Upgrading Practical Skills
2. Expansion and Refine Knowledge
3. Refine Particular Interest (more focused issues/specific concern)

Process and Duration of Study

The Undergraduate Architecture Program is conducted under the 2021 Curriculum, which uses a credit system with a minimum study load of 145 credits (SKS). The standard duration of study is 4 years or 8 semesters. There is also an optional one-year Professional Architect Education Program (PPAr), making the total study period 4+1 years. Each semester consists of 16 weeks of lectures, including mid-term and final examinations. There are two semesters in one academic year: the odd (first) semester, held from August to December, and the even (second) semester, held from February to July.

The Undergraduate Architecture Program supports the Merdeka Belajar Kampus Merdeka (MBKM) initiative launched by the Ministry of Education and Culture of the Republic of Indonesia in 2020. The Merdeka Belajar concept offers students the opportunity to study both within and outside their field of study, and both inside and outside UGM, with a credit load of up to 20 credits (SKS).

Admission

The admission system for new students is carried out through the Undergraduate Architecture Program's admissions process, which accepts graduates of high school (SMA), vocational school (SMK), or Islamic senior high school (MA). This process follows the scheme organized by the university. The criteria, requirements, and admission procedures are reviewed and updated annually based on evaluations from the previous year's implementation.

Undergraduate Program Admission Routes at UGM for the 2024/2025 Academic Year:

1. National Selection Based on Achievement (SNBP)
2. National Selection Based on Test (SNBT)
3. Independent Selection

Duration of Study: 4 years

Registration Fees: vary depending on the admission route.

Tuition Fees (UKT):

The fees vary based on the admission route and the student's financial capacity. In general, all students are classified into six groups:

- UKT Group 1 and 2: 100% subsidized Excellent Education Tuition
- UKT Group 3: 75% subsidized Excellent Education Tuition
- UKT Group 4: 50% subsidized Excellent Education Tuition
- UKT Group 5: 25% subsidized Excellent Education Tuition
- UKT Group 6: Full-rate (non-subsidized) Excellent Education Tuition

For students admitted through the Independent Selection route, there is also an Institutional Development Fee payable during the first year of study.
